The [Town of Sweden](#) along with the [Village of Brockport](#), located on the historic Erie Canal, offer much for visitors to our tournament. Explore downtown with its unique shops, go for a ride on the Erie Canal or check out SUNY Brockport during your stay. Many out of town teams also have taken a quick one hour excursion to Niagara Falls. Hamlin Beach State Park, on the shore of Lake Ontario, offers a place to picnic, hike and swim. Malls, restaurants, and many other attractions in the Greater Rochester area are close by and easily accessible.

Every effort will be made to place teams according to their level of play to provide the most competitive and exciting tournament experience possible. On behalf of the Brockport Blizzard Soccer Club, we wish you the best of luck in your soccer season and look forward to hosting your team in July!

### The event is open to ages U08-U19

U08-U10 teams may game roster up to 14 players. U11-U19 teams may game roster up to 18 players. (We do not accept recreational teams above U10, unless approved by the tournament director.) All teams may have up to 3 guest players. The guests players must be age appropriate travel players (house players will not be permitted without a valid player pass). No guest player may play below his or her age, division, or league level shown on player pass, even if age eligible. Premier players will not be permitted to guest play in the Travel B division. Canadian teams, please refer to the age matrix to determine the correct age bracket for your team. Tournament teams may enter the tournament, but must play at the highest level within an age or the next age level as determined by the Tournament Director.

### Divisions

- Premier: Highest level of competition, highly developed skills. Players usually selected from multiple towns.

- Travel A: Division 1 travel teams, advanced skills for age group. Players usually selected from one or two towns.
- Travel B: Division 2 or 3 travel teams, skills are emerging or basic. Players usually selected from one or two towns.

The tournament is open to boys' and girls' travel league, competitive, and premier teams. We do not accept recreational teams, unless approved by the tournament director.

Co-ed teams are allowed; but they must register as a boys' team.

### Player Eligibility and Restrictions

- Players must be in good standing with their state association.
- Players may only play on one team.
- All players must be eligible to play in their age group based on their date of birth.

U.S. Players: Players must not be older than division age group prior to December 31st of the year of the tournament, refer to the age matrix on the tournament website.

Canadian Players: Players must not be older than division age group prior to December 31st of the year of the tournament, refer to the age matrix on the tournament website.

- Player passes for each player, including guest players, must be carried by the coach/manager to all games for inspection by the referee.

### Guest Players

- A maximum of 3 (three) guest players per team are permitted.
- Players may only play on one team.
- No guest player may play below his or her age. **Premier players are not allowed to play in the Travel B division, even if playing up in age, unless determined appropriate by the tournament director.**

### General Information

The tournament will be held on July 22 & 23, 2017 in Brockport, N.Y. The first tournament games begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 22.

## Additional Information:

- The majority of the fields are located on school grounds that have formal policies restricting smoking, pets, alcohol, and fires.
- Please, no tailgate parties, camping, cooking, smoking, or alcohol on school premises.
- **No dogs on school premises.**
- Parking is available at all fields. Please follow all posted signs and attendants, if applicable.
